- 1. Completion of all necessary dual enrollment applications, placement testing, and class enrollment by the above deadlines are the responsibility of the student. All of these procedures vary from college to college, and it is the responsibility of the student to work with their college of choice to understand and complete their application and registration process. Failure to complete these requirements prior to the above deadlines will prevent the student from participating in dual enrollment.
- 2. For eligible students, the Huron School District will pay all applicable tuition and fees that do not exceed the statewide pupil weighted average foundation allowance (adjusted for the proportion of the school year the student is dual enrolled). If the total tuition cost exceeds this amount, the student or their parent/guardian will be responsible for the remaining balance. The student and/or their parent/guardian will be responsible for the cost of any and all textbooks required for the course(s).

- 3. In the event that the student fails to complete a district paid dual enrollment course, the student or their parent/guardian will be responsible for reimbursing the Huron School District all tuition and fees for that course per MCL 388.514(9) and MCL 388.1904(9). Family and medical emergencies as determined by the postsecondary institution are exempt from this stipulation.
- 4. Students are expected to regularly attend their dual enrollment classes.
- 5. Students will be responsible for providing transportation to and from the college campus where dual enrolled. Students are expected to have reliable transportation for the entire duration of the course(s). If the student is unable to complete a course due to transportation issues, the student may be expected to reimburse the school district per conditions outlined in section 2.
- 6. Upon successful completion of the course(s) students will be issued either a pass (G) or fail (U) grade by Huron High School. This is in addition to any grades issued by the college. The G or U grade will be on the student's high school transcript for the applicable trimester(s) of dual enrollment.
