WHAT IS DUAL CREDIT?

Program that allows a student to take approved courses that earn both college and high school credit.

Ex: If you take U.S. History at San Jac, you will receive credit for this class in college and at PMHS.

Application Process

- Attend the Information Meeting
- Join Dual Credit Schoology Course
- Complete steps in Schoology
- Fulfill testing requirements, if needed
- Provide proof of meningitis vaccination
- Complete DC enrollment form with Mrs. Evans
- Attend orientation with Mrs. Evans
- Pay for classes
- Purchase or rent textbooks
