

Dear Parents,

Welcome to Jessup Elementary! I am excited to begin the academic school year! I am writing this letter hoping that it will make the start of the school year a smooth one. The following are some basic facts about the operations of the school.



**Hours for all Grade Levels:**

- **7:00 am** School opens its doors for students to enter (drop off students suing the parking lot alongside the cafeteria side of the school).
- **7:30 am** breakfast served in the classrooms for all students PK-4.
- **7:45 am** The school day begins. Students are expected to be in class at this time. If arriving late a parent must bring student to front office.
- **3:05 pm** School starts dismissing students.

**Breakfast & Lunch:**

- Breakfast is free to all students at Jessup.
- A lunch application is required for all students to dete eligibility.

- We do not allow parents in the building to eat breakfast with students.
- The Fire Marshall has put strict limits on the number of people in the cafeteria at one time; therefore, we allow each PK-4 student two lunch visits per semester. We will allow visitors starting September 26.
- **DROPPING OFF LUNCH for students during the school day is not allowed.**

**Dismissal:**

- We do not check out students after 2:30.
- Changes to how a student is to get home must be made prior to 2:30.
- If picking up a student in your car, a school issued car tag must be presented during dismissal; if you do not have a tag, then you will be asked to go to the front office.
- If checking out a student from the office, a valid id is required.
- Only adults 18 or older listed on the enrollment documents will allowed to check out a student from school.
- Student dismissal options include car riders, bus riders, and day care.
