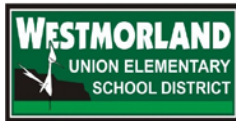

Interdistrict Petition Agreement for the 19-20 School Year

We are pleased to inform you of the approval of the Interdistrict Petition for your child to enroll in the Westmorland Union Elementary School District for the 2019-2020 School Year. Please read the following information carefully.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. An interdistrict petition agreement is valid only for the school year for which it is issued; permits expire at the end of each school year and ***MUST BE RENEWED ANNUALLY***. All interdistrict petitions are reviewed annually and the decision to approve or deny is based on Board Policy 5036 and district enrollment patterns.
2. An interdistrict agreement is valid only while the conditions stated in the request are maintained.
3. Falsification of information on the application for an interdistrict transfer is cause for immediate revocation of an interdistrict transfer approval and no further application will be considered.
4. Transportation to and from school shall not be provided for students attending on an interdistrict petition. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent /guardian.
5. **Students must be present in their classroom by 8:15 AM, and picked up promptly at dismissal time.** This includes dismissal times for tutoring, band, orchestra, yearbook, GATE, sports, or any other after-school activity.

Dismissal Times for Regular School Day:

1st – 3rd Grades – **2:35 p.m.**

4th – 6th Grades – **2:40 p.m.**

7th – 8th Grades – **2:55 p.m.**

Dismissal Times for Minimum Days:

1st – 6th Grades – **12:45 p.m.**

7th – 8th Grades – **12:50p.m.**

6. Students not picked up within 15 minutes of dismissal will need to be signed out by the parent through the school office.

An interdistrict agreement may be denied or revoked (EC 46600) at any time for the following reasons:

- o Student is excessively tardy or absent from school, or student is brought to school excessively early or left excessively late.
- o Student fails to uphold appropriate behavior standards.
- o Student fails to make appropriate academic efforts.
- o False or misleading information was provided.
- o Reason for the original issuance of the permit by the district of residence is no longer valid.
- o Other conditions that occur that would render continuance inadvisable.

Falsification of any information on the application for an interdistrict transfer is cause for immediate revocation of an interdistrict transfer approval and no further application will be considered.
